

Application to register a third party (an individual)

with the ECQ for a State Election

Post- GPO Boy 1202

The *Electoral Act 1992* (the Act) requires that a third party must be registered if the electoral expenditure incurred during the capped expenditure period for the election exceeds \$6,000.

The ECQ must maintain and publish a register of third parties on the ECQ's website.

The third party has an obligation to notify the ECQ of any change to details (Form QSGo₇) and must keep records in accordance with the Act. The Act requires all records to be kept for a period of 5 years.

There is a requirement to keep a State campaign account (s 215) that is a bank account solely used for all electoral expenditure and into which all donations, loan payments, and gifts are paid into.

The ECQ MUST be informed of the details of the State campaign account using Form QSG16C.
