

Nomination for the Legislative Assembly

For candidates endorsed by a registered political party

If you are nominating to be elected to sit in the Queensland Legislative Assembly you must:

- be enrolled on the electoral roll for the State of Queensland;
- an Australian citizen
- not a disqualified person under Subsection (2) or (3) of Section 64 of the *Parliament of Queensland Act 2001*.

It is the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that they are eligible for nomination.

Lodgement timeframe

A nomination will only be accepted from **the day after** the issue of the writ for the election. The Registered Officer or Deputy Registered Officer of the registered political party must submit nominations on behalf of the endorsed candidates, with payment of nomination deposits, to the ECQ **before noon on the cut-off day for nominations**.
