The ECQ was required to conduct a postal ballot to declare the position:

Postal Ballot

Postal ballot opened on Thursday, 5 September 2024 and closed at midday on Monday, 30 September 2024.

Aggregate statistics for the postal ballots were as follows:

Ballots issued

15,171 members were eligible to vote

15,171 ballot papers were initially posted to eligible members

Ballots returned

1,511 ballot envelopes were returned to ECQ

30 did not proceed to the ballot for the following reasons:

- Declaration envelopes returned with declaration slip removed
- Declaration on envelope was not signed
- Ballot paper returned outside of or no declaration envelope

A total of 1,481 declaration envelopes proceeded roll mark-off.

Note – 1 ballot paper equals up to fourteen (14) votes.
